Dear Friends & Neighbors,

As we prepare for another exciting season of recreation and leisure here in the Town of Babylon, I wanted to take a moment to address a matter of significant concern: the erosion issues at Overlook Beach. Despite the challenges we've faced due to recent storms and coastal erosion, I'm pleased to announce that Overlook Beach will indeed be open for business this season.

As a long-time resident of Babylon, I understand the importance of Overlook Beach to our community, serving as a cherished destination for beachgoers and young families alike. That's why the Town Board and I are committed to ensuring its preservation and accessibility for years to come.

In the wake of erosion challenges, I'm pleased to share with you that we have set aside necessary funding needed to mitigate erosion and further protect the facility later this fall. Specifically, we have already earmarked resources to purchase sand from an upcoming Army Corps of Engineers dredging project scheduled for the fall. Additionally, we will soon receive \$2 million from New York State through the Environmental Bond Act to protect existing infrastructure at Overlook. These funds will support ensuring the pavilion and other critical infrastructure is protected from future storms and erosion.

As you well know, Mother Nature has been relentless with coastal storms over the last six months, giving us limited time to thoroughly mitigate these issues prior to this season. While we are glad we will be able to open Overlook for the summer of 2024, please be reassured that more significant work is planned for later this fall.

Thank you for your continued concern about Overlook Beach, and I look forward to welcoming you to all of our parks facilities for a safe and enjoyable season ahead.





Town of Babylon Summer Programs

Online registration is available for residents for all programs, except individual music lessons. Any

resident with a User ID and Password can register online by Clicking Here.

Residents that need a USER ID and PASSWORD can create an account by <u>Clicking Here</u>. All new accounts created online will be given "non-resident status" until proof of residency is uploaded to your account. After creating your account, you will need to upload pictures of double proof of residency (NYS Drivers License and a current tax or utility bill) and birth certificates for all children in your household. Your account will be reviewed in 3 - 5 business days.

Non-residents can register for available programs in person and online (*select programs*). In person registration can be done at 151 Phelps Lane in North Babylon, Monday - Friday, 9 am - 4 pm. Please have the parent/guardian's license and child's birth certificate on hand when registering.

Low Enrollment Disclaimer: If a program doesn't meet minimum participation requirements, the Parks Department reserves the right to cancel the program. In the event a program is cancelled by the Parks Department, a full refund will be issued.



Please be advised that NO REFUNDS will be issued for any recreation programs. We encourage you to double check your calendar before signing up for any programs. We will only issue full refunds, if prior to the start of the program, a medical emergency prohibits an individual from taking part in the program. Please be advised that we will need to receive written confirmation from a physician that the individual is incapable of participating in the program. The Town of Babylon Aquatics Program incorporates guidelines set forth by the American Red Cross to teach the latest swimming and safety skills. Our morning Learn-to-Swim Program is for children ages 3 through 15. Lessons take place Monday through Friday, a half hour each day, for three weeks. Lessons take place in the morning, before our pools open to the public. If you have any questions, please call the Aquatics Office at 631-893-2118.

Program Information

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents only. Ages 3 - 15. Age is determined as of September 1, 2024

Registration: Online Only.

Session I Registration: Registration will open online on Wednesday, May 8 at 9 am for Session I and will close on Friday, May 31. Registration for Session I will not be possible after that date.

Session II Registration: Online registration, for swimmers who are NOT participating in Session I, will open online on Wednesday, June 5 at 9 am and will close on Friday, June 28.

Session II Registration for participants enrolled in Session I & ANY resident wishing to register for Session II: Registration will be available, online only, on Friday, July 19 from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm.

Your child's registration level is based on their 2023 American Red Cross Pass/Repeat Card. Their completion status was entered into our registration system at the end of the 2023 season.

Fee: \$60 per child, per session *No Refunds*

Swim Attire: All swimmers are required to wear a bathing suit to lessons. All swimwear must be clean. "Street clothes", sport bras, leotards, leggings, dri-fit wear, & compression shorts and shirts are not allowed. Underwear and undergarments are not allowed to be worn under swimsuits.

Each swimmer is allowed to register for 1 class per session. Participants who register for more than one class will not be given a refund. Only swimmers enrolled in Fitness Swimmer, Lifeguard Readiness, & Starts & Turns may register for more than one class.



Morning Swim Lessons - Level Descriptions

Children under age 6 are in classes based on age. Children 6 and older are in classes based on skill.

Pre-Beginners

Introduction to Level 1 skills. Separation class for children ages 3 and 4 ONLY. Parents do not accompany students into pool area. Students will be working on front and back floats, using arms, kicking and streamlines. Classes are held in the Kiddie Pool.

Jellyfish: Introduction to level 1 skills for 3 year olds only, 5:1 ratio

Porpoise: Introduction to level 1 skills for 4 year olds only, 6:1 ratio

*At Fabio Buttitta, swimmers age 3 & 4 will be in a combined class called Jellyfish/Porpoise.

Beginners

Swimmers must be a minimum of 5 years old to participate in the beginner program. Classes meet in the "big" pool. Students will be working on front and back floats, submerging under water and streamlines. Level 1 Introduction to Water Skills:

Shark: Level 1 skills, 5 year olds only, 8:1 ratio Manatee: Level 1 skills, 6 - 11 year olds, 10:1 ratio Teen: Multi-level beginner class for 12 - 15 year olds* *Anyone 16 years of age or older, please see description for Adult Lessons under Specialty Aquatics.

Once a swimmer receives an American Red Cross Level Card, advancement through the levels is based strictly by skill level. Age is no longer a factor. Swimmers MUST provide the appropriate Red Cross Skill Level Card to register for any of the following levels. Each new level builds upon skills learned in the previous level.

Advanced Beginners

Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills: ARC Level 1 card required. Students should be able to float comfortably on front and back prior to starting this class. Students will be working on freestyle and backstroke.

Level 3A Stroke Development: ARC Level 2 card required. Students should have perfected freestyle and backstroke. Students will be working on breaststroke and butterfly kick, jumping into deep water, and beginner diving.

Intermediate Swimmers

Level 3B Stroke Development: ARC Level 3A card required. All level 3A skills will be reviewed. Students will be working on swimming 15 yards of breaststroke and butterfly.

Level 4 Stroke Improvement: ARC Level 3B card required. Swimmers will be doing laps and must be able to swim 25 yards of freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly. Students will be working on standing dives, sidestroke, and refining all strokes.

Advanced Swimmers

Level 5 Stroke Refinement: ARC Level 4 card required. Students will be working on all strokes (50 yards) with proper stroke turns, 25 yards sidestroke, racing starts, and treading water for 2 minutes.

Level 6 Personal Water Safety: ARC Level 5 card required. Students will be working on all strokes (100 yards), 500 yard swim, all competitive starts and turns, surface dives, 20-yard underwater swim and treading water for 5 minutes.

Fitness Swimmer: ARC Level 6 card required. This is an endurance based swimming class. Students will be working on warm-ups, stretching, stroke drills, interval swimming, and completing a 500 yard swim. This course is 1 hour.

Lifeguard Readiness: Age 14, ARC Level 6 card or Fitness Swimmer Card required. Students will be working on the 500 yard swim, timed 50 yard freestyle. Basic lifeguarding skills will be introduced. This class covers the pre-skills testing required to get into the ARC Lifeguard Training Course. This course is 1 hour.



Advanced Swimming Programs

The following programs are designed for advanced swimmers that have completed our learn-to-swim program, hoping to pursue a job in the aquatics field. These programs are for mature individuals.

Junior Lifeguarding

This class is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge and skills for future lifeguards. Coursework will include endurance swimming, lifesaving skills and an introduction to first aid, CPR and AED training.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 10 - 12, ARC Level 6 card required Registration: Online only, Wednesday, May 8. Fee: \$75 Dates: Monday - Friday, July 8 - August 9 Time: 9 am - 10 am Location: Phelps Lane Pool, North Babylon *15 participant max.

Springboard Diving

The goal of springboard diving is to provide safe and educational diving lessons for beginner, intermediate & advanced students. Participants will receive ten lessons.

Eligibility: Residents and non residents, ages 8 and up. Age is determined as of July 8, 2024.

Registration: Online and walk-in registration is available for residents beginning **Wednesday, May 8**. Non-Residents can register beginning Wednesday, May 29.

WSI Aide

The purpose of this course is to provide training for water safety instructor aides to assist in conducting swimming and water safety courses. Ability to demonstrate swimming strokes and techniques will be required. Aides



will assist with preschool and beginner level classes. A water skills assessment and additional time spent volunteering are required. This class is intended for those candidates who exhibit maturity and have a strong sense of responsibility.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 13 - 15, ARC Level 6 card required Registration: Online only, Wednesday, May 8. Fee: \$75 Dates: Monday - Friday, July 8 - August 9 Time: 8 am - 9 am (1 hour class) *Plus 20 hours of additional volunteer time Location: Phelps Lane Pool, North Babylon *15 participant max.

Volunteer Instructor (VIT)

This program is designed for swimmers who are 14 and 15 years old, have successfully completed the WSI Aide course, and who hope to pursue a job as an instructor in the future. VITs will work closely with instructors assisting with classes as needed. A letter of community service will be awarded at the end of the program.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 14 - 15, WSI Aide Card required

Candidates for the VIT program will be called to schedule an interview in June.

Important information about the following programs

Participation in the following programs does NOT entitle the participant, nor their family, to a day of swimming at the pool. Once the class is over, participants will be escorted out of the facility. If you would like to remain at the facility to swim, you must exit and pay the entrance fee. Anyone with a pool plan, may show their 2024 pool passes to the pool attendants.

Infant & Toddler Swim

The following programs require children and parents to come to lessons wearing their swimsuits. For those students not completely potty-trained, a swim diaper is required.

Aqua Tot (AT)

This class is designed for children 6 months to 2.5 years old, as of July 1, 2024. This infant/toddler program is a water adjustment class that requires parent participation in the "big" pool. Instructors will use songs and water games to enhance the skills introduced.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 6 months - 2.5 years old

Registration: Online only, Wednesday, May 8.

Fee: \$60 per parent/child pair

Dates: Mondays & Wednesdays, July 1 - July 31 OR Tuesdays and Thursdays, July 2 - August 6 (No Class Thursday, July 4th)

Times: 12:15 pm - 12:45 pm

Location: Anthony Sanchez Pool, Phelps Lane Pool, *North Lindenhurst Pool

*Monday and Wednesday session ONLY

Starfish (SF)

This class is designed for 2.5 - 3.5 year olds, as of July 1, 2024 with parent participation. Starfish will follow the same guidelines as the Jellyfish and Porpoise classes with a parent's help to keep the students on task. Class will be conducted in the kiddie pool.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 2.5 - 3.5 years old

Registration: Online only, **Wednesday, May 8**. **Fee:** \$60 per parent/child pair

Dates: Mondays & Wednesdays, July 1 - July 31 OR Tuesdays and Thursdays, July 2 - August 6 (No Class Thursday, July 4th)

Time: 12:00 pm - 12:30 pm

Location: Anthony Sanchez Pool, Phelps Lane Pool, *North Lindenhurst Pool

*Monday and Wednesday session ONLY.

Adaptive Aquatics

The Town of Babylon Aquatics program will offer swimming lessons for children with special needs. Basic swimming and water safety skills will be introduced. Class will progress at the child's pace.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 5 - 25, age is determined as of September 1, 2024.

Registration: Online only, Wednesday, May 22. *Registration is limited to 6 swimmers per session Fee: \$50 per child for 8 lessons

Dates: Tuesdays & Thursdays, July 9 - August 1 Times:

Session 1: 5:00 pm - 5:30 pm Session 2: 5:30 pm - 6:00 pm Session 3: 6:00 pm - 6:30 pm

Location: North Lindenhurst Pool, North Lindenhurst

Additional Required Documents Due By June 20th

For Participants in Adaptive Aquatics Only: *A Physician's Fitness Statement is required and must be mailed or faxed (631-893-2123) to the Aquatics Office by June 20, 2024. Please be sure to print the "About Me" document. It will be emailed to you along with your receipt once you have successfully registered for the program. Please print, fill out the documents, and mail or fax them to the Aquatics Office by June 20th. If you do not return the documents by this date, you will lose your spot in the program. No refunds will be issued.

Intramural Swim Team

The following program is not meant to take the place of swim lessons, only to add to what is being taught. Focus will be on racing techniques. For specific and individual stroke work, attend regular lessons as well.

This program is not swim lessons. It is to improve already learned skills. Swimmers must know all competitive strokes

Intramural Swim Teams representing the town pools will practice weekly and compete at regularly scheduled swim meets. Practices will be held twice weekly and meets will be held on Saturday mornings at Phelps Lane. The program will conclude with an Annual Championship Swim Meet. Registration is limited to 45 swimmers per team.

Registration

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents, ages 7 - 16 (age is determined as of September 1, 2024), who are able to swim at least 25 meters unassisted. American Red Cross Lifeguarding Certification Class

The purpose of the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is to provide entry-level lifeguard participants with the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services personnel take over. To enroll in the Lifeguarding course, you must be at least 15 years old before the last scheduled class session. NYS identification will need to be provided on the first day of class.

To successfully complete the course, you must attend the entire course, participate in all skill sessions/ drills, activities and scenarios, and demonstrate competency in all required skills and situations. The practice sessions will require some strenuous physical activity. You are encouraged to check with your health care professional before participating in the practice sessions. If you have a medical condition or disability that might prevent you from participating in the activities, or have questions about the course or being able to fully participate in the Lifeguarding course, please contact the instructor to discuss this before the course begins. Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, valid for 2 years.

Fees: Residents: \$400 Non-Resident: \$450 This includes the course and the certification through the American Red Cross. If swimming skills aren't up to par with the American Red Cross standards on the first day, you will be dismissed from the course and given a full refund.

NOTE: If you don't already have an account, an adult over 18 must create the Parks website online account, then the child must be added to the account by uploading a birth certificate. To gain residency status, parents must upload a license and utility bill as well.

Also please note: Participants must have their own e-mail account. This will be the e-mail they will use with the American Red Cross for the entirety of their lifeguarding career. Parent or family e-mails are NOT accepted.

Pre-course work: After you register online, you will be provided with a link within 3 business days to create an American Red Cross account. The American Red Cross mandates students to complete a 7-hour online video course accompanied by questions. This can be done over multiple days. **Once you have completed the online video course, you will print the completion certificate and submit it on the first day of class.**

Pre-Test: To participate in the physical portion of the course, you must be able to:

- Swim 300 yards continuously, demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing. You may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles may be used.
- Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs.
 You will place your hands under your armpits.
- Complete a timed event within 40 seconds.
- Swim 20 yards. Your face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed.
- Surface dive, feet-first or head-first, to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object then return to the surface and swim 20 yards on your back to return to the starting point with both hands holding the object while keeping your face at or near the surface so you are able to get a breath. You cannot swim the distance under water.
- Make various types of saves on other classmates.
- Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

Camping Permit

Camping permits are required for all campers. This allows residents access to Cedar Marina Campground with their camper. Overnight Camping Permits may be purchased at the Parks & Recreation Office located at 151 Phelps Lane in North Babylon, Monday - Friday, 9 am - 4 pm.

Permit Fee: Residents: \$50 Senior Citizens (60+): \$25 *Permit includes 1 camper permit and 1 tow vehicle permit* *Note: Tow Vehicle Permit may only be used during your reservation at the campground.

Camping Permit Requirements:

- 1. Driver's License with address in the Town of Babylon
- 2. Current Tax Bill or Utility Bill with matching name and address to license
- 3. Camping Vehicle Registration with matching name and address to license & bill.
- 4. NYS Tow Vehicle Registration with matching name and address to license & bill.

Name and address must match on all documents. Permits cannot be purchased without the above requirements. No exceptions will be made. Senior Citizens (60 or older) must show proof of age for Senior Discount.

Campground Facility & Fees

Facility: Cedar Marina Campground, Ocean Parkway; (631) 669-5949 Parking lot is resident only with 2024 Beach Permit. Campsites are by reservation and a permit is required.

Cedar Marina Campground is available for overnight camping (self-contained camping vehicles only). The facility contains 41 campsites that are available for online reservation. Reservations are Friday at 12 noon to the following Friday at 10 am. Any sites not reserved online will be available first come, first served.

NYS Access Pass & Lifetime Liberty Pass

The Town of Babylon Beaches accept the New York State Access Pass, as well as the New York State Lifetime Liberty Pass, for vehicle admittance into the Town Beaches, in lieu of a Beach Pass purchased through the Town. This courtesy will enable a Town resident access to Overlook Beach, Cedar Beach, Gilgo Beach, Cedar Marina, Venetian Shores and Tanner Park parking lots. The New York State Access Pass is a N.Y. State Park disability pass. You must present your NYS individual access pass along with your NYS Drivers License and Car Registration showing you are a Town of Babylon resident to gain access to Town facilities.
