Town of Babylon Summer Programs

Program Registration

Online registration is available for residents for all programs, except individual music lessons. Any resident with a user ID and password can register online by visiting www.TownofBabylonNY.gov/parks.

Residents that need a USER ID and PASSWORD can create an account by visiting:
<https://nybabylonweb.myvscloud.com/webtrac/web/household.htm>.

All new accounts created online will be given "pending status" until proof of residency is uploaded to your account. After creating your account, you will need to upload pictures of double proof of residency (NYS Drivers License and a current tax or utility bill) and birth certificates for all children in your household. Your account will be reviewed in 3 - 5 business days.

Non-residents can register for select programs in person and online. In person registration can be done at 151 Phelps Lane in North Babylon, Monday - Friday, 9 am - 4 pm. Please have the parent/guardian's license and child's birth certificate on hand when registering.

Low Enrollment Disclaimer: If a program doesn't meet minimum participation requirements, the Parks Department reserves the right to cancel the program. In the event a program is cancelled by the Parks Department, a full refund will be issued.

Refund Policy

Please be advised that NO REFUNDS will be issued for any recreation programs. We encourage you to double check your calendar before signing up for any programs. We will only issue full refunds, if prior to the start of the program, a medical emergency prohibits an individual from taking part in the program. Please be advised that we will need to receive written confirmation from a physician that the individual is incapable of participating in the program. We thank you and hope you are able to enjoy the many programs and events the Town of Babylon Department of Parks, Recreation & Cultural Affairs has to offer.

Eligibility: Town of Babylon residents only. Ages 3 - 15. Age is determined as of September 1, 2026.

Registration: Online Only.

Session I Registration: Registration will open online on **Tuesday, May 5** at 9 am for Session I and will close on Friday, May 29. Registration for Session I will not be possible after that date.

Session II Registration: Online registration, for swimmers who are NOT participating in Session I, will open online on **Wednesday, June 3** at 9 am and will close on Friday, June 26.

Session II Registration for participants enrolled in Session I & ANY resident wishing to register for Session II: Registration will be available, online only, on **Friday, July 17** from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm.

Your child's registration level is based on their 2025 American Red Cross Pass/Repeat Card. Their completion status was entered into our registration system at the end of the 2025 season.

Fee: \$75 per child, per session

Program Dates: *No makeup classes*
Session I: Monday, June 29 - Friday, July 17
Session II: Monday, July 20 - Friday, August 7

Times: Classes are held between 8 am and 12 pm.

Learn-To-Swim Lessons for Kids

The Town of Babylon Aquatics Program incorporates guidelines set forth by the American Red Cross to teach the latest swimming and safety skills. Our morning Learn-to-Swim Program is for children ages 3 through 15. Lessons take place Monday through Friday, a half hour each day, for three weeks. Lessons take place in the morning, before our pools open to the public. If you have any questions, please call the Aquatics Office at 631-893-2118.

Locations: Anthony Sanchez Pool, West Babylon; Fabio Buttitta Pool, Deer Park; North Lindenhurst Pool, North Lindenhurst; Phelps Lane Pool, North Babylon

Swim Attire: All swimmers are required to wear a bathing suit to lessons. All swimwear must be clean. "Street clothes", sport bras, leotards, leggings, dri-fit wear, & compression shorts and shirts are not allowed. Underwear and undergarments are not allowed to be worn under swimsuits.

Each swimmer is allowed to register for 1 class per session. Participants who register for more than one class will not be given a refund. Only swimmers enrolled in Fitness Swimmer, Lifeguard Readiness, & Starts & Turns may register for more than one class.



Level Descriptions

Children under age 6 are in classes based on age. Children 6 and older are in classes based on skill.

Pre-Beginners

Introduction to Level 1 skills. Separation class for children ages 3 and 4 ONLY. Parents do not accompany students into pool area. Students will be working on front and back floats, using arms, kicking and streamlines. Classes are held in the Kiddie Pool.

Jellyfish: Introduction to level 1 skills for 3 year olds only, 5:1 ratio

Porpoise: Introduction to level 1 skills for 4 year olds only, 6:1 ratio

*At Fabio Buttitta, swimmers age 3 & 4 will be in a combined class called Jellyfish/Porpoise.

Beginners

Swimmers must be a minimum of 5 years old to participate in the beginner program. Classes meet in the "big" pool. Students will be working on front and back floats, submerging under water and streamlines. Level 1 Introduction to Water Skills:

Shark: Level 1 skills, 5 year olds only, 8:1 ratio

Manatee: Level 1 skills, 6 - 11 year olds, 10:1 ratio

Teen: Multi-level beginner class for 12 - 15 year olds*

*Anyone 16 years of age or older, please see description for Adult Lessons under Specialty Aquatics.

Once a swimmer receives an American Red Cross Level Card, advancement through the levels is based strictly by skill level. Age is no longer a factor. Swimmers MUST provide the appropriate Red Cross Skill Level Card to register for any of the following levels. Each new level builds upon skills learned in the previous level.

Advanced Beginners

Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills: ARC Level 1 card required. Students should be able to float comfortably on front and back prior to starting this class. Students will be working on freestyle and backstroke.

Level 3A Stroke Development: ARC Level 2 card required. Students should have perfected freestyle and backstroke. Students will be working on breaststroke and butterfly kick, jumping into deep water, and beginner diving.

Intermediate Swimmers

Level 3B Stroke Development: ARC Level 3A card required. All level 3A skills will be reviewed. Students will be working on swimming 15 yards of breaststroke and butterfly.

Level 4 Stroke Improvement: ARC Level 3B card required. Swimmers will be doing laps and must be able to swim 25 yards of freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly. Students will be working on standing dives, sidestroke, and refining all strokes.

Advanced Swimmers

Level 5 Stroke Refinement: ARC Level 4 card required. Students will be working on all strokes (50 yards) with proper stroke turns, 25 yards sidestroke, racing starts, and treading water for 2 minutes.

Level 6 Personal Water Safety: ARC Level 5 card required. Students will be working on all strokes (100 yards), 500 yard swim, all competitive starts and turns, surface dives, 20-yard underwater swim and treading water for 5 minutes.

Fitness Swimmer: ARC Level 6 card required. This is an endurance based swimming class. Students will be working on warm-ups, stretching, stroke drills, interval swimming, and completing a 500 yard swim. This course is 1 hour.

Lifeguard Readiness: Age 14, ARC Level 6 card or Fitness Swimmer Card required. Students will be working on the 500 yard swim, timed 50 yard freestyle. Basic lifeguarding skills will be introduced. This class covers the pre-skills testing required to get into the ARC Lifeguard Training Course. This course is 1 hour.



Advanced Swimming Programs

The following programs are designed for advanced swimmers that have completed our learn-to-swim program, hoping to pursue a job in the aquatics field. These programs are for mature individuals.

Junior Lifeguarding

This class is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge and skills for future lifeguards. Coursework will include endurance swimming, lifesaving skills and an introduction to first aid, CPR and AED training.

1. Swim front crawl for 100 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side.
2. Tread water for one minute using arms and legs
3. Dive to a depth of 10 feet
4. Float on back for 30 seconds or swim on your back for 25 yards using the backstroke
5. Submerge and swim a distance of 15 feet underwater

American Red Cross

The purpose of the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills needed to:

- Prevent, recognize and respond to aquatic emergencies in both shallow and deep water.
- Provide professional-level care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services (EMS) professionals take over.

The total instructional time for the Lifeguarding course in-person sessions is 21.5 hours. To enroll in the Lifeguarding course, you must be at least 15 years old before the last scheduled class session. During the first in-person session, you will be required to provide proof of age and identity. Acceptable forms of identification include a driver's license, state identification card, passport, or birth certificate.

Pre-Test: To participate in the course, you must be able to pass a prerequisite swimming skills evaluation, which includes two parts and takes place during the first in-person session.

- Jump in, submerge, resurface and swim 150 yards continuously, tread water for 2 minutes, and then swim 50 more yards. While swimming, you must keep your face in the water and demonstrate good breath control. You may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both. Swimming on the back or side is not permitted. Swim goggles are allowed. When treading, you must use only your legs.
- Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. Your face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed. Surface dive (head-first or feet-first) to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on your back to return to the starting point, holding the object at the surface with both hands and keeping your face at or near the surface. Swimming the distance underwater is not permitted. Exit the water without using a ladder or the steps.

This course follows a blended learning model, which combines online coursework with in-person sessions. You will receive an email from the American Red Cross with instructions for accessing the online course once you enroll and pay through the TOB. The online course content is designed to be completed in approximately 6 hours. Please be prepared to provide proof that you completed the assigned online modules prior to the first in-person session using one of the following methods:

- Print your module completion record at the conclusion of the course.
- Log in to the online course to show the completion status.

To successfully complete the course and receive a certification, you must:

- Complete all online course content in advance of the corresponding in-person sessions.
- Attend the entire course and participate in all in-person sessions.
- Actively participate in all course activities, including assuming various roles during skill practices, skill drills, activities and scenarios.
- Demonstrate proficiency in all skills.
- Successfully pass the final written exam with a minimum grade of 80 percent.
- Pass three final skill assessments.

Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding (Including Deep Water) with CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and First Aid, valid for 2 years. Please be aware that the skill practice sessions in the Lifeguarding course involve strenuous physical activity. If you have any concerns about your ability to participate fully in class, please contact the instructor before signing up to discuss possible accommodations. Lifeguarding Certification

Fees: Residents: \$400 Non-Resident: \$450

This includes the course and the certification through the American Red Cross. If swimming skills aren't up to par with the American Red Cross standards on the first day, you will be dismissed from the course and given a full refund.
